
HELPFUL TIPS

- Wedding hairstyles and bridal makeup plans should be formulated at least 4 months before the event. Have your hair stylist show you some pictures of their work on brides or of special event hairstyles. Bring in the wedding hair pictures displaying the styles you like the best.

- Pictures are one of the best ways to avoid bridal hair disasters. Pictures will help eliminate misunderstandings between you and your hair stylist. Remember, pictures are for inspirations only. The actual style of your hair may vary by the texture, length, and condition of your hair.
- Be practical. Try a style that is comfortable for dancing and moving around. Consider the wedding locations climate (humid, dry, wet, cold, too hot). Your wedding hair styles should match with the style of your dress and your personality. Keep your desired bridal hair styles in mind when picking out accessories.
- All bridal party members should come to their hair appointment with an idea of the look they would like to achieve.
- All bridal party members should shampoo their hair the day before their scheduled service. Updos/Styles will retain their look longer and less frizz when the hair is not freshly shampooed.
- All bridal party members are advised to wear buttoned-down shirts or tank tops.
- PLEASE, no wet hair on the wedding day! It would take up extra time to blow dry the hair and result of extra charge too.
- Bring your favorite lip stick or lip gloss for lip retouch.
- Extra safety pins.
